NYAGV Communications Vice President Alfredo Valentin

On 8/8/94, Valentin's 17-year old son Derek, accompanied by his best friend Charles Simmonds of Brooklyn went to what the young Valentin thought was going to be a fistfight over a girl. He was

going to meet another teen named Marco to settle the dispute. Derek Valentin stepped out of a car on the corner of Barnes and Allerton Avenues in the northeast Bronx and confronted Marco. Suddenly, someone stepped forward with a gun and started firing, killing Derek Valentin instantly, and shooting Simmonds who died later at Jacobi Hospital. Shooter jailed 33 1/3 years to life.

Interesting contributors to NYAGV PAC

Agnes Gund, president of New York's Museum of Modern Art, is the daughter of investor George Gund Jr., who sold his decaffeinated coffee firm (Sanka) to Kellogg in 1927, and left his family \$1.9 billion when he died in 1966. Mother Jones magazine lists Gund on their Mother Jones Top 400 as one of the nation's top contributors. She donated \$2000 to the NYAGV PAC and was their single largest individual contributor in 2000. Ms. Gund also made direct contributions to notorious antigunners Assemblywoman Deborah Glick (\$250), Thomas Abinanti (\$1000) for his failed Senate bid, Attorney General Eliot Spitzer (\$3000), Senator Roy Goodman (\$5000), and Congresswoman Carolyn Maloney (\$5000). She has also donated to NYC Mayoral candidates Mark Green (\$3500), Alan Hevesi (\$4500), and Peter Vallone (\$4500), plus NYC Comptroller candidate Herbert Berman (\$2500), Manhattan Boro President C. Virginia Fields (\$3500), and NYC City Councilwoman Eva Moskowitz (\$1500). In January 2002, she gave \$30,700 to Carl McCall. In all, Ms. Gund has donated over \$100,000 since 1999 to antigun incumbents and antigun challengers and is a major contributor to the NYS Democratic Committee.

Other well-connected NYAGV PAC contributors include:

- Lisa Perry, a self-described philanthropist, gave \$1000. She has donated \$40,000 to the New York State Democratic Committee and another \$10,000 to the Andrew Cuomo for Governor Committee. She has given at least \$65,000 to the Democratic National Committee, \$26,000 to the Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee, and \$2000 to Hillary Clinton. Newsmax.com reported on September 14, 2000, "White House sources told

Fox that a New York couple, Lisa and Richard Perry, who donated to Mrs. Clinton's campaign four times in 1999, and gave thousands of additional dollars to the Democrat Party, spent the night in the Lincoln bedroom after a dinner party. The sources added that Mrs. Clinton called Lisa Perry and asked her specifically what she wanted in exchange for the contributions."

- Susan Patricof, \$250. Ms. Patricof, along with her husband Alan, have made political donations in excess of \$60,000 to various radical left-wing candidates and causes within New York State including a \$5000 check to the NYS Democratic Committee in July 2001. As the former finance chairman of Hillary Clinton's Senate campaign, she donated \$111,000 to the Democratic National Committee and \$5000 to the New York Democratic Victory 2000 fund. Mother Jones magazine lists her as one of the *"Persons that the President or First Lady came to know during or after the 1992 Campaign"* and the July 12, 2001 issue of the East Hampton Star reports the Clintons were overnight guests at their estate. Along with Congresswoman Lowey, the Patricof's now head the fundraising arm of the Democratic Congressional Campaign Committee. According to the March 29, 2001 issue of Roll Call *"...Lowey was able to pull in new donors to the committee, including Susan and Alan Patricof, finance chairmen for Hillary Clinton's Senate bid, who held an event at their home that raised \$700,000."*
- Michael Kerr, President of M&R Management Company, \$250. He has donated \$30,000 to Governor Pataki's 2002 re-election campaign thus far, in addition to \$10,000 to the NYS Senate Republican Campaign in 2000.
- Florence Frucher, CEO of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange and COO Ryan Community Health Network, \$100. She and her husband have donated \$25,000 to Andrew Cuomo, \$2000 to Mark Green, and \$5000 to the Democrat New York Senate 2000 fund.
- Maureen Cogan, a publisher at Art & Auction and Vice-Chair of the Children's Defense Fund, \$500. Over the past two years she has made more than \$10,000 in political contributions including ones to Democrats Mark Green (\$2500), Alan Hevesi (\$4500), and Councilwoman Eva Moskowitz (\$2500), plus to Republicans Governor George Pataki (\$2000) and Sen. Roy Goodman (\$1000).
- Roy Furman, president of Furman Selz Capitol Management LLC, \$500. Mr. Furman, also listed on the Mother Jones Top 400, has given \$15,000 to the Democratic National Committee, \$10,000 to the Democratic New York Senate 2000 fund, plus \$1000 each to Hillary Clinton and Mark Green. The April 1996 issue of Mother Jones described him, *"Furman is a media investor for Furman Selz Inc., and a self-proclaimed Republican who turned coat and endorsed Bill Clinton in 1992. One month after Furman wrote a check to the Democratic Party, Clinton introduced him as a member of the party leadership."* The February 27, 1997 edition of the Washington Post reported his donations of \$110,000 to Democrats earned him an invitation to one of the infamous White House "coffees" on September 7, 1995.

- Eugene Mercy Jr., a partner at Granite Capital International, \$250. His recent contributions include those to NYC Mayoral candidates Fernando Ferrer (\$2000), Alan Hevesi (\$2000), and Peter Vallone (\$1000), plus NYC Public Advocate candidate Kathryn Freed (\$2000). His other donations include \$5000 to the New Jersey Democratic State Committee, \$2000 to the Democratic National Committee, \$2000 to Congresswoman Nita Lowey, and \$2000 to Al Gore.
- Jason Lilien, an attorney at Weil, Gotshaw, and Manges LLP, \$150. Mr. Lilien has donated over \$4000 to the 2001 local races in New York City including \$1900 to Alan Hevesi.
- William Bernhard, self-employed “foundation executive”, \$250. Mr. Bernhard has given to Peter Vallone (\$1000), Fernando Ferrer (\$750), and NYC Public Advocate candidate Betsey Gotbaum (\$1000).
- Jeffrey D. Stewart, founder of the NYAGV PAC, \$150. Stewart is Vice President of Communications, Loews Hotels, and Chief of Staff to the Chairman & CEO, Jonathan M. Tisch. In 1998, he served as Finance Director to Charles Schumer's Senate campaign.
- Martin Brennan, Political Director, NYS Trial Lawyers Association, \$100.

NYAGV had only two corporate donors, LHP Consulting and Management Company (\$2500) and Titan Industrial Foundation (\$500), both based in New York City.
